Joining them, our invited speakers will provide insights into Buddhist philosophy, neuroscience and mental health, phenomenology of empathy, Jungian psychotherapy and cultural adaptations, hermeneutics and the whole person discourse, and the ethical controversies and dilemmas in psychiatric practice.

Free paper sessions will allow delegates the opportunity to be involved in the program participating in symposia, and oral and poster sessions.
