Accredited Membership

Fellows of the College may apply for Accredited Membership of the Faculty of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (FCAP) based on the following criteria:

- Completed the RANZCP Certificate of Advanced Training in Child and Adolescent Psychiatry; OR
- Completed an alternative approved training program in child and adolescent psychiatry; AND
- Be currently working in child and adolescent psychiatry or a related field (e.g. perinatal or youth mental health)

Eligibility Assessment:

The Chair, Subcommittee Advanced Training Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (SATCAP), is responsible for the initial assessment of the eligibility of the application. Applicants must then be approved by the FCAP bi-national committee.

Applicants who are not successful in attaining Accredited membership of the Faculty will be provided with feedback (including necessary actions required prior to attaining Accredited membership of the Faculty), and will be able to retain membership of the Faculty.

Application Process:

Upon completion of the RANZCP Certificate in Advanced Training in Child and adolescent Psychiatry, all RANZCP Fellows will be invited to join the Faculty as an Accredited Member.

All other applicants must complete a letter of application, demonstrating the relevant qualifications and experience that meet the Accredited Membership criteria.
