* **CURRENCY** is determined as documented under the 2003 Regulations in **LINK 19**. If current, date attained will remain as per original date of attainment, NOT as per date Trainee is transitioned. Mandatory rotations refreshed via the completion of 10 cases in that AOP will be credited with the associated EPAs for that rotation. No training time will be credited during transition. If mandatory rotation is refreshed via the completion of a 3 month FTE rotation, 3 FTE training months and the associated EPAs for that AOP will be credited during transition. (i.e: should a trainee have refreshed Acute rotation by completing a 3 FTE month Adult run, then the 3 months and Antipsychotic use EPA will be credited)

† Under the 2003 Regulation for Clinicals, the trainee must have completed a minimum of 30 FTE months of BT (i.e.: 5 of 6 Rotations), before attempting Clinical Examinations.

Transitioning Trainee will still need to undertake 1 x OCA per rotation as per the 2012 Training Program Regulations, and **have to complete a minimum of four OCAs** prior to Fellowship.

** Should there be more applicants than available places in a Certificate program, the completion of summative assessments may be favourably viewed in the selection process.

^ Two of the three Psychotherapy EPAs must be completed in order to progress to Stage 3

† Should a trainee have completed ≥ 3 FTE months and less than <6 FTE months, trainee will be awarded 1 EPA.

†† If credited and therapy informed by psychodynamic principles for at least 40 sessions has not been completed, the trainee is required to complete the 40 sessions prior to the award of Fellowship.

§ Under the 2003 Regulation for entry to AT the trainee may commence AT without having passed Clinicals. No more than 12 FTE months pre-Clinical Advanced Training may be credited until the Clinical Examination has been passed. In addition, the Trainee is NOT eligible to enrol for a Certificate course. THESE 2003 REGULATIONS REMAIN IN AFFECT UNTIL THE TRAINEE HAS TRANSITIONED TO 2012 PROGRAM. AT THAT POINT, TRAINEE MAY APPLY TO ENTER A CERTIFICATE PROGRAM. TRAINEE MUST ALSO COMPLETE ANY REMAINING TRAINING TIME IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FELLOWSHIP.

~ Forensic is not a recognised Basic Training AOP under the 2003 Regulations. In order to receive credit for both the Forensic rotation and EPAs, the trainees DOT is required to demonstrate that an approved Forensic rotation was undertaken.
