This Award is presented on an annual basis and takes the form of an award for a **Fellow of the College in Queensland** who has made significant sustained contribution to the practice of psychiatry in a clinical, academic or administrative capacity. An additional award may be presented in any given year **to an agency or individual who is not a College Member**, who has contributed to the improvement of mental health in Queensland.

In weighing up the relative merits of a range of nominated individuals, the selection panel may consider whether a particular nominee's achievements have already received significant public recognition.

The Queensland Branch Committee is responsible for this award. The Award shall comprise of an engraved medallion and certificate presented at the General Meeting of the Queensland Branch. We seek your nomination of a College Fellow and/or agency or individual who is not a College member, to be considered for this award.
