- 3) Submit only one (1) soft copy of your exemption submission, i.e. thesis/article/project. **This is to be one (1) PDF.** The exemption submission, if it is a thesis or project is to be saved as one file, not as separate files (cover page, table of contents, project, and references).
- 4) The naming convention for each file is to follow this format:
RANZCP ID_FAMILY NAME, First Name_Forms_ date of submission.
RANZCP ID_FAMILY NAME, First Name_supplementary documentation_date of submission.

- 8) Email your submission by the published closing date as per the RANZCP's Examination Timetable on the website.
