

### **Registration**

- Candidates will be required to present primary ID for check-in and, sign and confirm they have read the RANZCP Candidate Rules Agreement.
- Candidates will be provided a seating number during registration. The seating number will be your assigned seat in the exam room.
- Phones to be turned off and placed in candidate's individual bags.


### **Accessing the exam**

Candidates to sit in their assigned allocated seat. Each workstation will have scratch paper with your username and password. Please check your full name and RANZCP ID on the login sheet. If there is a mismatch, please raise your hand.

During the exam, candidates must place their IDs on the desk for invigilators to verify if needed.

Candidates must wait for instructions before turning over their scratch paper or using the computer. The scratch paper contains your username and password for logging into the exam platform.

When directed candidates should be able to see the exam platform login page on their screen:
